214 Cases of Drowning This Summer

Since the beginning of the swimming season that started in mid-March 2018 and until today, August 22nd 2018, MDA teams treated 214 drowning victims, 54 cases ended in death including 13 children under the age of 10.

MDA teams provided medical treatment in 214 cases of drowning, most of them occurred in the Mediterranean coast. So far 116 cases of drowning in the Mediterranean Sea, 31 in public swimming pools, 8 on the shores of the Dead Sea, 20 in private pools, 5 in the Sea of Galilee, 6 case in Eilat, 1 case in Gan Hashlosha and 3 in the Jordan river, 2 in the Yarkon river. In many cases, the teams were required to quickly and professionally handle several numbers of drowning victims at the same time.

Big Laughs for Little Lives

On Sunday, 12th of August, the Australian Friends of Magen David Adom in Sydney held their annual campaign evening in support of the first and only Human Milk Bank currently being constructed at the William H. Bloomberg Station in Jerusalem and which will be operated by MDA.

"For many years it was considered only a dream but now it is becoming a reality. For many premature babies and their parents the Human Milk Bank (aka Mother's Milk Bank) will be an addition to the lifesaving efforts undertaken to help these babies become healthy infants" said Dr. Sharon Bransburg-Zabary during her keynote speech at the event which took place at the exclusive Royal Randwick Racecourse in Sydney.

Some 450 supporters were first welcomed at the receptions which showcased some of MDA's lifesaving abilities alongside interactive displays which played accounts of patients and survivors saved by MDA. Amongst the showcases was an impressive Command & Control stand which allowed for everyone to see the technology behind the scenes which MDA developed and how this is helping to shorten response and treatment times. Alongside this was

a real MDA Medicycle with which many had their photos taken with. Both the displays drew a lot of attention and interest.

As the evening progressed Australian Friends of MDA Immediate Past President, Mr. Rolly Nagel, was honored by his successor, Mr. Tony Ziegler and MDA Israel's Australian Desk Manager Ido Gutin. The two surprised Nagel with photos of a lifesaving medicycle donated in his honor and which has begun its service a few days prior in the Lachish Region. The main event was headlined by Jewish American comedian, Elon Gold, who with great humor about the Jewish community world-wide captured the hearts and smiles of the crowd for some very hilarious comic relief.

"We are proud to be supporting the Mother's Milk Bank project which is another testament to the important work of Israel's national EMS", said President Tony Ziegler.

Australian Friends of MDA CEO, Doron Lazarus thanked the supporters for their year-long contributions and help to MDA especially towards the many babies whose lives can now be saved by this project.

The next day, August 13th, another hall was filled with some 400 young supporter of YMDA who were also entertained by Gold and together supported MDA Israel.

Edna's Ray of Light

Edna Efrat (81 years old) from Kfar Ye'Hoshua in the north of Israel will never forget that Tuesday one month ago. MDA received a call about a woman who was not feeling well in an office building in Tel Aviv. First to arrive were 2 MDA EMTs on their Medi-Cycles, followed by an MDA MICU. Keren Or, MDA Paramedic diagnosed that the patient was suffering from a severe Heart Attack and provided without any delay, assisted by her team, lifesaving medical treatment. During the treatment Edna developed a life threatening cardiac arrhythmia and lost consciousness. Keren, together with the EMT - Rami Chanut and the Paramedic intern Rina Handlich resuscitated Edna, and managed to regain a pulse after a few minutes, and evacuated her directly to the hospital Cardiology Cath Lab.

Edna remembers, when she was checked and treated inside the MICU, that she envisioned her late friend that passed away two and a half years ago. Only after she woke up in the hospital she realized that Keren brought her back to life, one of the doctors told her that she nearly died and the two female paramedics in the MDA MICU saved her life. She knew that she will find Keren to hug her and thank her in person, she is the sunlight of my life.

Three weeks later Edna visited the hospital for a routine checkup. At the ambulance parking in front of the ER, she began looking for Keren, describing her to one of the hospital team members. Soon after, Keren came with a patient to the hospital, met with Edna with deep emotions, hugging one another and crying in joy. For Keren it was the first time that she meets in person one of her patients that she resuscitated, fully recovered without any physical damage.
